1. • **Maillart 1er Cru Brut NV, France** £35.50
A truly remarkable champagne. The high percentage of Pinot Noir lends elegance and finesse with the Chardonnay contributing to weight
2. **Mumm Cordon Rouge NV, France** £36.50
• Clean and subtle on the nose. Rich fruit in the mouth - yellow peaches/apricots with toasted nuts
3. **Moet et Chandon NV** £37.95
• One of the best known and most stylish of the top houses

4. **Cava Castell Llord Brut, Spain** £18.50
• Soft, creamy sparkler from Northern Spain, zesty fresh fruit and a wonderfully clean, dry finish
5. **Berri Estate Cuvee Brut, Australia** £19.75
• A soft fruity, sparkling wine with a lively effervescence. A blend of Colombard and Chenin Blanc grapes are used to give a subtle taste yet good length
6. **Rene Barbier Brut Reserva NV, Spain** £22.50
• A very elegant Cava, clean citrus on the nose, backed by soft fruit aromas of peach and melon; the palate is marked by purity and a fine mousse

7. **Chenin Blanc, Robertson Valley, South Africa** £14.00
• A fresh, clean, zesty acidity with elegant fruit: melons, lemons and lychees
8. **Riddle Colombard Chardonnay Australia** £14.50
• A combination of the zingy Colombard with the fuller, richer style of Chardonnay. A non-oak finish which is a refreshing, easy drinking lively wine
9. **Semillon Chardonnay, Cranswick Smith, Australia** £15.75
• This offers a finely honed blend of citrus fresh, vibrant fruits and a creamy, rich structure
10. **Casa La Joya Sauvignon Blanc, Chile** £15.80
• Pale yellow with fresh green tints and characteristically aromatic. Fragrant and very fruity with good, fresh acidity
